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previous three test administrations, times \$530.

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Subd. 4. Numeracy proficiency aid. Numeracy proficiency aid for each school is
equal to the product of the school's numeracy proficiency allowance times the number
of eighth grade pupils at the school on October 1 of the previous fiscal year. A school's
numeracy proficiency allowance is equal to the percentage of students in each building
that meet or exceed proficiency on the eighth grade math Minnesota Comprehensive
Assessment, averaged across the previous three test administrations, times \$530.
Subd. 5. Numeracy growth aid. Numeracy growth aid for each school is equal to
the product of the school's numeracy growth allowance times the number of eighth grade
pupils enrolled at the school on October 1 of the previous fiscal year. A school's numeracy
growth allowance is equal to the percentage of students at that school making medium or
high growth, under section 120B.299, on the eighth grade math Minnesota Comprehensive
Assessment, averaged across the previous three test administrations, times \$530.
