Subdivision 1. Voluntary Plan. The commissioners of health and education may must jointly develop a plan to encourage require school districts to accurately and efficiently test for the presence of radon in public school buildings serving students in kindergarten through grade 12. For purposes of this section, buildings also include the Minnesota State Academies in Faribault and the Perpich Center for Arts Education in Golden Valley. To the extent possible, the commissioners shall base the plan on the standards established by the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

Subd. 2. **Radon testing.** A school district may must include radon testing as a part of its ten-year facility plan under section 123B.595, subdivision 4. If a school district receives authority to use long-term facilities maintenance revenue to conduct radon testing. The district shall conduct the testing according to the radon testing plan developed by the commissioners of health and education.

Subd. 3. **Reporting.** A school district that has tested its school buildings for the presence of radon shall must report the results of its tests to the Department of Health in a form and manner prescribed by the commissioner of health and the Department of Education in a form and manner prescribed by the commissioner of education.
