\$1,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of health, for the biennium ending June 30, 2019, to provide grants to pharmacists and other prescription drug dispensers, health care providers, local law enforcement, local health and human services departments, and other entities to purchase omnidegradeable, at-home prescription drug deactivation and disposal products to assist individuals in the disposal of prescription drugs in a safe, environmentally sound manner.
