1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 122A.30, is amended to read:

1.6 **122A.30 EXEMPTION FOR CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION**
1.7 **INSTRUCTORS.**

1.8 ~~(a)~~ Notwithstanding section 122A.15, subdivision 1, and upon approval of the local
1.9 employer school board, a person who teaches in a ~~part-time~~ vocational or career and technical
1.10 education program and demonstrates occupational competency based on work experience
1.11 in business or industry is exempt from a license requirement. Nothing in this section shall
1.12 exclude licensed career and technical educators from the definition of "teacher" in section
1.13 122A.40, 122A.41, or 179A.03.

1.14 ~~(b) This section expires June 30, 2020. After this section expires, persons who teach in~~
1.15 ~~a part-time vocational or career and technical education program may apply for a teaching~~
1.16 ~~license provided in sections 122A.18 to 122A.184.~~
