BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. CLAY COUNTY RESOURCE RECOVERY CAMPUS.
- 1.7

Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$8,500,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
- 1.8

to the Pollution Control Agency for a grant to Clay County under the solid waste capital
- 1.9

assistance grants program under Minnesota Statutes, section 115A.54, to construct a new
- 1.10

resource recovery campus consisting of a new solid waste transfer station and problem
- 1.11

materials facility. Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 115A.54, this appropriation
- 1.12

does not require any nonstate contribution.
- 1.13

Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
- 1.14

proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
- 1.15

the state in an amount up to \$8,500,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
- 1.16

prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 1.17

Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
