1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. <u>ALLEY RENOVATION; SPRING GROVE.</u>

1.6 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$1,150,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds

1.7 <u>fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to the</u>

1.8 <u>city of Spring Grove for predesign, design, construction, and construction management</u>

1.9 to redesign and renovate three alleys in downtown Spring Grove: the Northwest Alley,

1.10 north of Main Street, from Second Avenue NW to Division Avenue; the Southwest Alley,

1.11 south of Main Street, from Second Avenue SW to Division Avenue; and the Southeast

1.12 Alley, south of Main Street, from Division Avenue to First Avenue SE. This project

1.13 includes new surfacing of the alleys and adjacent publicly owned areas, improved storm

1.14 water management, additional greening, a storm water pond and rain garden, and an

1.15 improved pedestrian and bike environment. This appropriation is not available until

1.23 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
