Board to adopt standards for an endorsement enabling licensed high school teachers 1.3 to provide dual enrollment instruction at a high school; amending Minnesota 1.4 Statutes 2018, section 122A.09, by adding a subdivision. 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 122A.09, is amended by adding a subdivision 1.7 to read: 1.8 Subd. 12. Endorsement; dual enrollment instruction. The Professional Educators 1.9 Licensing and Standards Board must issue an endorsement for dual enrollment instruction 1.10 to a high school teacher licensed in a content-specific field who successfully completes a 1.11 one-year district preparation program in providing dual enrollment instruction in the teacher's 1.12 licensure field, consistent with board-adopted standards. The board must adopt standards 1 13 for this endorsement in consultation with eligible public postsecondary institutions 1 14 participating in course agreements under section 124D.09, subdivision 10. The endorsement 1.15 means a change in the teacher's license that allows the teacher to teach postsecondary college 1.16 in the schools dual credit courses under section 124D.09, subdivision 10, at a high school 1.17
