Sales tax authorized. (a) Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 1.9 477A.016, or any other contrary provision of law, ordinance, or city charter, the city of 1.10 Hermantown may, by ordinance, impose an additional sales tax of up to one percent on 1.11 sales transactions taxable pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, chapter 297A, that occur within 1.12 the city.
