BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 97C.315, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

Subdivision 1. **Lines.** An angler may not use more than one line except:

1.8

(1) two lines may be used to take fish through the ice; ~~and~~

1.9

(2) the commissioner may, by rule, authorize the use of two lines in areas designated by

1.10

the commissioner in Lake Superior; and

(3) two lines may be used to take fish during the open-water season by a resident or

1.12

nonresident angler who purchases a second-line endorsement for \$5. The proceeds collected

1.13

from the purchases of second-line endorsements must be spent on walleye stocking.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective March 1, 2020.
