- 1.1 A bill for an act
- 1.2 relating to game and fish; allowing two lines for angling to take fish with
- 1.3 second-line endorsement; amending Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 97C.315,
- 1.4 subdivision 1.
- 1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 97C.315, subdivision 1, is amended to read:
- 1.7 Subdivision 1. **Lines.** An angler may not use more than one line except:
- 1.8 (1) two lines may be used to take fish through the ice; ~~and~~
- 1.9 (2) the commissioner may, by rule, authorize the use of two lines in areas designated by
- 1.10 the commissioner in Lake Superior; and
- 1.11 (3) two lines may be used on waters not subject to special regulations to take fish during
- 1.12 the open-water season by a resident or nonresident angler who purchases a second-line
- 1.13 endorsement for \$5. The proceeds collected from the purchases of second-line endorsements
- 1.14 must be spent on walleye stocking.
- 1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective March 1, 2020.
