Subd. 3. **Definitions** As used in this section, the phrase "written instruments relating to or affecting real estate" embraces every writing relating to or affecting any right, title, or interest in real estate, and includes, among other things, plats and wills. "Prohibited provision" embraces all clauses, stipulations, restrictions, covenants, and conditions of the kind or character referred to in subdivision 1. "Single or double occupancy residential home" means a single-family home or duplex designed to have one or two residential living units in a stand-alone building, but not more than two units. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective on August 1, 2021, and applies to real

estate conveyances executed on or after that date.
