BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.4 Section 1. CLOSED LANDFILL CLEANUP PROGRAM; FREEWAY LANDFILL. 1.5 Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$72,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds 1.6 fund to the commissioner of the Pollution Control Agency to design and construct remedial 1.7 systems and acquire land at closed landfills throughout the state in accordance with the 1.8 closed landfill program under Minnesota Statutes, sections 115B.39 to 115B.42. 19 Of this appropriation, \$2,000,000 is available only if the Freeway Landfill in Dakota 1.10 County is acquired under the program. The remainder of this appropriation is available as 1.11 follows: \$35,000,000 is available beginning in fiscal year 2020, and notwithstanding 1.12 Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.642, is available until June 30, 2025, and \$35,000,000 is 1.13 available beginning in fiscal year 2022, and notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 1.14 16A.642, is available until June 30, 2027. If the Freeway Landfill is acquired under the 1.15 program, these amounts are to be used first for that project. 1 16 Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond 1.17 1.18 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of the state in an amount up to \$72,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect 1.19 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota 1.20 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7. 1.21 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment. 1.22
