1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money to renovate the five historic

1.3sites in Cook County; authorizing the sale and issuance of state bonds.

1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. **RENOVATION HISTORIC SITES; COOK COUNTY.**

1.6Subdivision 1. **Appropriation.** \$1,092,650 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund

1.7to the commissioner of employment and economic development for a grant to Cook County

1.8for the following purposes:

1.9(1) to predesign, design, construct, furnish, and equip the renovation of the following

1.10Historic Cook County sites: (i) the Cook County History Museum; (ii) the Johnson Heritage

1.11Post Art Gallery; (iii) the Bally Blacksmith Shop; (iv) the St. Francis Xavier Church, also

1.12known as the Chippewa City Church; and (v) 1930s Nee-Gee Fishing Tug and Fish House;

1.13and

1.14(2) to complete design for and to construct, furnish, and equip a new collections storage

1.15facility in Cook County.

1.16This appropriation is available when the commissioner of management and budget determines

1.17that sufficient resources have been committed to complete the project, as required by

1.18Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.

1.19Subd. 2. **Bond sale.** To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond

1.20proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of

1.21the state in an amount up to \$1,092,650 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

- 2.1 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
- 2.2 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.
- 2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
