1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to capital investment; appropriating money for water, sanitary sewer, and

1.3storm sewer infrastructure in the city of Lakefield; authorizing the sale and issuance

1.4of state bonds.

1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. LAKEFIELD; WATER, SANITARY SEWER, AND STORM SEWER

1.7INFRASTRUCTURE.

1.8Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$6,000,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund

1.9to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the city of Lakefield to predesign, design,

1.10construct, and equip the replacement of publicly owned infrastructure and facilities. This

1.11appropriation includes money for a new municipal water treatment facility and distribution

1.12system to provide clean drinking water to residents; new wastewater treatment ponds and

1.13collection system as well as improvements to the existing wastewater treatment facility;

1.14storm sewer collection system and infrastructure; street reconstruction; and for other

1.15improvements and betterments of a capital nature to publicly owned infrastructure in the

1.16city.

1.17Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond

1.18proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of

1.19the state in an amount up to \$6,000,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

1.20prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota

1.21Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.22EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
