1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. PERFORMANCE MEASUREMENT STUDY.
1.6	(a) The commissioner of the Office of Higher Education shall conduct a performance
1.7	measurement study to develop measurable higher education accountability goal metrics for
1.8	the University of Minnesota and Minnesota State Colleges and Universities system. The
1.9	commissioner shall:
1.10	(1) study and develop a performance measurement system and evaluation framework,
1.11	including specific performance measures, with which to evaluate the institutions;
1.12	(2) develop metrics that ultimately will compare institutional performance with the
1.13	performance of peer institutions with similar missions and characteristics; and
1.14	(3) actively seek input from and consult with higher education segments and stakeholders
1.15	as appropriate.
1.16	(b) The objectives of the measurement system shall include, but are not limited to, the

1.19	(2) recruiting and graduating qualified undergraduate and graduate students;

1.21	(4) eliminating disparities;
