1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. [10.582] VETERANS' VOICES MONTH.

- 1.6 The month of October is designated as Veterans' Voices Month in recognition of the
- 1.7 state's desire to honor, recognize, and celebrate the contributions of veterans. Schools,
- 1.8 organizations, and communities in the state are encouraged to hold events and programs
- 1.9 that honor veterans and educate students and citizens about the unique culture of the
- 1.10 military by sharing and studying veterans' experiences through stories, essays, poetry, and
- 1.11 art from the men and women who have served in the armed forces. The state declares that
- 1.12 in order to educate the public, the governor may promote and encourage the observance of
- 1.13 <u>Veterans' Voices Month.</u>
- 1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
