1.11	other shelter on the ice of state waters is subject to section 97C.363.
1.12	Sec. 2. [97C.363] STORING GARBAGE AND OTHER WASTE ON ICE.
1.13	Subdivision 1. Prohibition. A person using a shelter, a motor vehicle, or any other
1.14	conveyance on the ice of state waters may not deposit garbage, rubbish, cigarette filters,
1.15	debris from fireworks, offal, the body of a dead animal, litter, sewage, or any other waste
1.16	outside the shelter, motor vehicle, or conveyance unless the material is:
1.17	(1) placed in a container that is secured to the shelter, motor vehicle, or conveyance;
