

1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to health; exempting pools that are owned and operated by a private  
1.3 organization from the definition of a public pool; amending Minnesota Statutes  
1.4 2008, section 144.1222, by adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2008, section 144.1222, is amended by adding a  
1.7 subdivision to read:

1.8 Subd. 2e. **Swimming pools owned and operated by a private organization.** A  
1.9 pool that is located outside on private property that meets the following requirements shall  
1.10 be considered a private residential pool for the purposes of this section, section 157.16,  
1.11 and Minnesota Rules, chapter 4717:

1.12 (1) the pool is owned and operated by a private organization that is organized as  
1.13 a corporation;

1.14 (2) the use of the pool is limited to members of the organization and the members'  
1.15 invited guests;

1.16 (3) the members must pay an initial membership fee to join the organization and an  
1.17 annual fee to use the pool; and

1.18 (4) no more than 20 families may use the pool during a season.
