1.6	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 151.214, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
1.7	Subd. 2. No prohibition on disclosure. No contracting agreement between an
1.8	employer-sponsored health plan or health plan company, or its contracted pharmacy benefit
1.9	manager, and a resident or nonresident pharmacy registered licensed under this chapter,
1.10	may prohibit the :
1.11	(1) a pharmacy from disclosing to patients information a pharmacy is required or given
1.12	the option to provide under subdivision 1; or
1.13	(2) a pharmacist from informing a patient when the amount the patient is required to
1.14	pay under the patient's health plan for a particular drug is greater than the amount the patient
1.15	would be required to pay for the same drug if purchased out-of-pocket at the pharmacy's
1.16	usual and customary price.

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
