BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

## Section 1. APPROPRIATION; CULTURALLY SPECIFIC FOOD SHELF.

\$100,000 in fiscal year 2020 and \$100,000 in fiscal year 2021 are appropriated from the 1.6 general fund to the commissioner of human services to provide a grant to an organization 1.7 that provides emergency services and referrals for American Indian families and operates 1.8 a culturally specific food shelf on the east side of the seven-county metropolitan area. Grant 1.9 funds must be used for the food shelf to purchase, transport, and coordinate the distribution 1.10 of nutritious food to needy individuals and families. 1.11
