BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 171.07, subdivision 15, is amended to read:

Subd. 15. **Veteran designation.** (a) At the request of an eligible applicant and on payment

of the required fee, the department shall issue, renew, or reissue to the applicant a driver's

1.9

license or Minnesota identification card bearing a graphic or written designation of:

1.10

(1) Veteran; or

1.11

(2) Veteran 100% T&P.

(b) At the time of the initial application for the designation provided under this

1.13

subdivision, the applicant must:

1.14

(1) be one of the following:

1.15

(i) a veteran, as defined in section 197.447;

1.16

(ii) a retired member of the National Guard or a reserve component of the United States

1.17

armed forces, who provides documentation demonstrating that the applicant qualifies for

1.18

nonregular retirement or reserve retirement;

1.19

(iii) a member of the National Guard or a reserve component of the United States armed

1.20

forces, who provides a Veteran Identification Card; or

2.1 (iv) a member of the National Guard or a reserve component of the United States armed
2.2 forces, who provides a Veteran Health Identification Card;

2.3 (2) have provide a certified copy of the veteran's applicant's federal form DD-214 or
2.4 form NGB-22 discharge papers, that confirms an honorable or general discharge under
2.5 honorable conditions status; and

2.6 (3) if the applicant is seeking the disability designation under paragraph (a), clause (2),
2.7 provide satisfactory evidence of a 100 percent total and permanent service-connected
2.8 disability as determined by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.

2.9 ~~(e) The commissioner of public safety is required to issue drivers' licenses and Minnesota~~
2.10 ~~identification cards with the veteran designation only after entering a new contract or in~~
2.11 ~~coordination with producing a new card design with modifications made as required by~~
2.12 ~~law.~~

2.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE; APPLICATION.** This section is effective August 1, 2022, and
2.14 applies to applications submitted on or after that date.
