1.8	avoidable infections and to promote best practices in sanitation, no person shall offer for
1.9	sale in Minnesota any cleaning product that contains triclosan and is used for sanitizing or
1.10	hand and body cleansing.
1.11	Subd. 2. Exception. The prohibition in subdivision 1 shall not apply to individual
1.12	products for which specific United States Food and Drug Administration approval for
