1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 216B.2402, subdivision 16, is amended to

1.8 Subd. 16. **Low-income household.** "Low-income household" means a household whose

1.9 household income:

1.10 (1) is ~~60~~ 80 percent or less of the state area median household income- for the geographic

1.11 area in which the low-income household is located, as calculated by the federal Department

1.12 of Housing and Urban Development; or

1.13 (2) meets the income eligibility standards, as determined by the commissioner, required

1.14 for a household to receive financial assistance from a federal, state, municipal, or utility

1.15 program administered or approved by the department.

1.16 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
