1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 120A.22, subdivision 8, is amended to read:
1.6	Subd. 8. Withdrawal from school. (a) Any student who is 17 years old who seeks to
1.7	withdraw from school, and the student's parent or guardian must, with the student's parent
1.8	or guardian:
1.9	(1) attend a meeting with school personnel to discuss the educational opportunities
1.10	available to the student, including alternative educational opportunities; and
1.11	(2) sign a written election to withdraw from school.
1.12	(b) A student who withdraws from school under paragraph (a) must complete the
1.13	remainder of the school year as a full-time online learning student under section 124D.095.
1.14	(c) A student who completes the school year as an online learning student under paragraph
