## Section 1. MAJOR LEAGUE SOCCER STADIUM; ON-SALE LICENSE. 1.5

Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.404, subdivision 1, or any other 1.6

- 1.7 law to the contrary, the city of St. Paul may issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license
- to the operator of the Major League Soccer stadium located in the city of St. Paul or to 1.8
- entities affiliated with it for operation of food and beverage concessions at the stadium. 1.9
- The license may authorize sales both to persons attending any and all events, and sales in 1.10
- a restaurant, bar, or banquet facility at the stadium. The license authorizes sales on all 1.11
- days of the week. All provisions of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 340A, not inconsistent 1.12
- with this section, apply to the license under this section. The license may be issued for a 1.13
- space that is not compact and contiguous, provided that the licensed premises may include 1.14
- only the space within the stadium or on stadium premises or grounds, as described in 1.15
- the approved license application. 1.16
