1.2 relating to agriculture; clarifying application of fugitive emission standards to

1.3 certain commodity facilities; amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 116.07,

1.4 by adding a subdivision.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 116.07, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7 to read:

1.8 Subd. 7f. **Temporary grain storage facility; fugitive emissions standards.** (a)

1.9 Monitoring requirements and discharge levels for fugitive emissions under agency rules do

1.10 not apply to operations of a dry bulk agricultural commodity facility that use portable

1.11 equipment to handle grain stored in a temporary storage facility.

1.12 (b) For the purposes of this subdivision, "temporary storage facility" means a facility

1.13 designed for the temporary storage of grain that:

1.14 (1) uses an asphalt, concrete, or comparable base material;

1.15 (2) has rigid, self-supporting sidewalls;

1.16 (3) provides adequate aeration;

1.17 (4) provides an acceptable covering; and

1.18 (5) provides for the storage of dry bulk agricultural commodities for up to one year.
