BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 160.293, subdivision 3, is amended to read:

Subd. 3. Number of trunk highway intersections or interchanges. (a) Unless otherwise provided in paragraph (b), a specific service sign for a rural agricultural or tourist-oriented business, place of worship, restaurant, motel, resort, recreational camping area, or gasoline service station or other retail motor fuel business is limited to one intersection or interchange on the trunk highway system.

(b) Specific service signs are permitted at two intersections or interchanges on the trunk highway system if the place of business is located (1) more than one-half mile from the nearest trunk highway intersection or interchange, and (2) within five miles of two or more trunk highways. Additional signing may be considered when the place of business is located between, or approximately an equal distance from, two or more trunk highways.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
