OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
 1.2 relating to health; clarifying requirement that a dispenser of a controlled substance
 1.3 must require the person purchasing the controlled substance to present a valid
 1.4 photographic identification; amending Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 152.11,
 1.5 subdivision 2d.

1.6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.7 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 152.11, subdivision 2d, is amended to read:

1.8 Subd. 2d. **Identification requirement for ~~Schedule H or III~~ controlled substance**
 1.9 **prescriptions.** ~~(a)~~ No person may dispense a controlled substance included in ~~Schedule H~~
 1.10 ~~or III~~ Schedules II through V without requiring the person purchasing the controlled
 1.11 substance, who need not be the ~~person~~ patient for whom the controlled substance prescription
 1.12 is written, to present valid photographic identification, unless the person purchasing the
 1.13 controlled substance, ~~or if applicable the person for whom the controlled substance~~
 1.14 ~~prescription is written~~, is known to the dispenser. A doctor of veterinary medicine who
 1.15 dispenses a controlled substance must comply with this subdivision.

1.16 ~~(b) This subdivision applies only to purchases of controlled substances that are not~~
 1.17 ~~covered, in whole or in part, by a health plan company or other third-party payor.~~
