OFFICIAL STATUS

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
Section 1. CASCADE LAKE REGIONAL PARK; ROCHESTER.
Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$2,750,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund
to the commissioner of natural resources for a grant to the city of Rochester to predesign,
design, construct, furnish, and equip improvements of a capital nature, including a pavilion,
an amphitheater, performance facilities, picnic shelters, restroom facilities, play areas, park
access, and landscaping. This appropriation is available when the commissioner of
management and budget determines that sufficient resources have been committed to
complete the project, as required by Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.502.
Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond
proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of
the state in an amount up to \$2,750,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect
prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota
