1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5Section 1. CLIMATE CHANGE IMPACTS ON STATE CAPITAL FUNDING

1.6NEEDS; APPROPRIATION.

1.7\$..... in fiscal year 2021 is appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of

1.8natural resources, in coordination with other state agencies, to assess the impacts of climate

1.9change, including the increase in heavy precipitation and storm events, on state-owned

1.10assets and to estimate the capital funding needs associated with those impacts. The

1.11commissioner must submit a report with the findings to the chairs and ranking minority

1.12members of the house of representatives and senate committees and divisions with jurisdiction

1.13over capital investment by January 15, 2021. This is a onetime appropriation.
