1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 181A.04, subdivision 5, is amended to read:
- Subd. 5. **Hazardous occupations.** (a) No minor under the age of 18 shall be permitted to work in any occupation which the commissioner shall find to be particularly hazardous for the employment of children under 18 years of age or detrimental to their well-being. A list of such occupations shall be established and promulgated by rule pursuant to section 181A.09.
- 1.12 (b) Notwithstanding any law or rule to the contrary, this subdivision does not apply to
  1.13 the following:
- 1.14 (1) minors employed in retail stores that are nonseasonal and are of a nontransient nature 1.15 and which sell or offer for sale explosives or pyrotechnics; or
- 1.16 (2) minors, at least 16 years of age, employed in a fixed site amusement park in the
  1.17 loading or unloading of passengers on rides or in the operation of amusement rides, as
  1.18 defined in section 184B.01.
