- 1.14 <u>Subd. 2.</u> <u>Application.</u> <u>A city or county may apply for a grant under this section on a</u>
- 1.15 form and in a manner prescribed by the commissioner. The commissioner shall establish
- 1.16 <u>criteria for awarding a grant under this section</u>. Priority shall be given to projects that
- 1.17 leverage federal money and maximize the use of state money, and that provide safe shelter
- 1.18 to areas of the state that regularly experience extreme weather events.
