OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
 1.2 relating to state government; requiring a report to the legislature on the receipt of
 1.3 federal funds by the state; proposing coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes,
 1.4 chapter 16A.

1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. **[16A.104] FEDERAL FUNDS REPORT.**

1.7 The commissioner must report to the chairs and ranking minority members of the house
 1.8 of representatives Ways and Means and senate Finance Committee on receipt of federal
 1.9 funds by the state. The report must be submitted with the governor's detailed operating
 1.10 budget in accordance with section 16A.11, subdivision 1, in an odd-numbered year and
 1.11 within ten days prior to the start of the regular session in accordance with section 3.3005,
 1.12 subdivision 2, in an even-numbered year. The report must include the total amount of federal
 1.13 funds received by the state in the fiscal year ending the prior June 30 and the total amount
 1.14 of federal funds anticipated to be received by the state in the current fiscal year. For each
 1.15 category of federal funding, the report must list:

1.16 (1) the name of the federal grant or federal funding source, the federal agency providing
 1.17 the funding, a federal identification number, a description of the purpose of the federal
 1.18 funding, and an electronic address at which additional relevant documents related to the
 1.19 grant or funding program may be found;

1.20 (2) the amount of federal funding the state received through that grant or source in the
 1.21 fiscal year ending the prior June 30 and the total amount of federal funds anticipated to be
 1.22 received by the state in the current fiscal year;

1.23 (3) if there is a federal maintenance-of-effort requirement associated with the funding;

2.1 (4) the number of full-time equivalent state employees assigned to implement the federal
2.2 funding's purpose;

2.3 (5) the amount of funds spent, as a match or otherwise, in conjunction with receipt of
2.4 the federal funding in the fiscal year ending the prior June 30, and the amount of funds
2.5 anticipated to be spent in the current fiscal year, listing state and nonstate sources of spent
2.6 funds separately; and

2.7 (6) the maximum amount of the federal funds that may be used for indirect costs
2.8 associated with implementing the funds' purpose.
