BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

- Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 18B.34, subdivision 5, is amended to read: 1.6
- Subd. 5. Fees. (a) A person initially applying for or renewing a noncommercial applicator license must pay a nonrefundable application fee of \$50, except an applicant who is uses pesticides in the course of performing official duties as: (1) a government employee; (2) a contractor providing rest area custodial services for the commissioner of transportation; or 1.10 (3) a Conservation Corps Minnesota employee who uses pesticides in the course of 1.11 performing official duties must pay a nonrefundable application fee of \$10. 1.12
 - (b) A license renewal application received after March 1 in the year for which the license is to be issued is subject to a penalty fee of 50 percent of the application fee. The penalty fee must be paid before the renewal license may be issued.
- (c) An application for a duplicate noncommercial applicator license must be accompanied 1.16 1.17 by a nonrefundable application fee of \$10.
