1.5	Section 1. TRUNK HIGHWAY MOWING OR HAYING; PERMIT MORATORIUM.
1.6	(a) Except as provided in paragraph (b), the commissioner of transportation must
1.7	implement a moratorium until April 30, 2019, on enforcing permits under Minnesota Statutes,
1.8	sections 160.232 and 160.2715, or any other Minnesota statute or administrative rule, to

- 1.9 <u>mow or bale hay in the right-of-way of a trunk highway.</u>
- 1.10 (b) This section applies regardless of the date of any permit issuance. This section does
- 1.11 not apply to a right-of-way adjacent to land under the jurisdiction of the state or a political
- 1.12 <u>subdivision.</u>
- 1.13 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
