1.7	benefits to any member or pay any expenses, except usual and customary administrative
1.8	expenses, until the relief association either:
1.9	(1) obtains the consent of the governing body of the city of Maplewood to any amendment
1.10	of the articles of incorporation, bylaws, or plan document of the relief association adopted
1.11	since January 1, 2018, that is intended to convert the relief association's plan from a defined
1.12	benefit plan to either a hybrid defined benefit and defined contribution plan or a defined
1.13	contribution plan; or
1.14	(2) pays to the city of Maplewood the lesser of:
1.15	(i) an amount equal to the surplus over full funding as determined under Minnesota
1.16	Statutes, section 424A.092, subdivision 3, paragraph (b), clause (3), based on an audited
1.17	annual financial statement for the year ended December 31, 2017; or
1.18	(ii) an amount equal to all contributions made by the city of Maplewood to the special
