1.9	is restricted to seniors, as defined by section 462A.37, subdivision 1, paragraph (h), and
1.10	that receives low-income housing tax credits provided under section 42 of the Internal
1.11	Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The rent in any rent-restricted unit in a project may
1.12	not increase in any 12-month period by a percentage more than the greater of:
1.13	(1) the percentage that benefit amounts for Social Security or Supplemental Security
1.14	Income recipients were increased pursuant to United States Code, title 42, sections 415(i)
1.15	and 1382f, in the preceding 12-month period, minus one percent; or
