BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 97A.338, is amended to read:

97A.338 GROSS OVERLIMITS OF WILD ANIMALS; PENALTY.

- (a) A person who takes, possesses, or transports wild animals over the legal limit, in elosed season, or without a valid license, in violation of the game and fish laws when the restitution value of the wild animals is over \$1,000 or more but less than \$2,000 is guilty of a gross overlimit violation. Except as provided in paragraph (b) (c), a violation under this paragraph is a gross misdemeanor.
- (b) A person who takes, possesses, or transports wild animals in violation of the game and fish laws when the restitution value of the wild animals is \$2,000 or more is guilty of a felony gross overlimit violation. Except as provided in paragraph (c), a violation under this paragraph is a felony.
- (c) If a wild animal involved in a gross overlimit violation is listed as a threatened or 1.16 endangered wild animal, the penalty in paragraph (a) does penalties in paragraphs (a) and 1.17 (b) do not apply unless more than one animal is taken, possessed, or transported in violation 1.18 1.19 of the game and fish laws.
