1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. ARDEN HILLS; OLD HIGHWAY 10 TRAIL.

1.7Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$2,050,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund

1.8to the commissioner of transportation for a grant to the city of Arden Hills for property and

1.9easement acquisition, design, and construction of a pedestrian and bicycle trail along Old

1.10Highway 10 North, from Lake Valentine Road to Lakeshore Place, to connect to the existing

1.11regional trail along County State-Aid Highway 96.

1.12Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond

1.13proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of

1.14the state in an amount up to \$2,050,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect

1.15prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota

1.16Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7.

1.17EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
