1.1 A bill for an act

1.2 relating to housing; establishing a pilot program providing grants for integrated

1.3 community-based housing; appropriating money.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. **INTEGRATED COMMUNITY-BASED HOUSING PILOT PROJECT;**

1.6 **APPROPRIATION.**

1.7 \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2022 is appropriated from the general fund to the Housing

1.8 Finance Agency for competitive grants to nonprofits to provide supportive housing for the

1.9 integrated community-based housing pilot project. Money appropriated in this section is

1.10 for the construction, acquisition, and rehabilitation of permanent supportive housing that

1.11 provides integrated community-based settings for people with disabilities and elderly

1.12 individuals seeking to remain within their communities. This is a onetime appropriation

1.13 and is available until June 30, 2023.
