OFFICIAL STATUS

1.1 A bill for an act
1.2 relating to health; insurance; requiring coverage for ectodermal dysplasia; proposing
1.3 coding for new law in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 62A.

1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.5 Section 1. 62A.3096 **COVERAGE FOR ECTODERMAL DYSPLASIA.**

1.6 Subdivision 1. **Definition.** For purposes of this section "ectodermal dysplasia" means a
1.7 genetic disorder involving the absence or deficiency of tissues and structures derived from
1.8 the embryonic ectoderm.

1.9 Subd. 2. **Coverage.** A health plan must include coverage for treatment of ectodermal
1.10 dysplasia.

1.11 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2019, and applies to health
1.12 plans offered, issued, or sold on or after that date.
