1.5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6 Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2016, section 410.121, is amended to read:

1.7 **410.121 SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR OR WINE; FAVORABLE VOTE**
1.8 **LICENSES.**

1.9 ~~If the charter which is to be amended or replaced contains provisions which prohibit the~~
1.10 ~~sale of intoxicating liquor or wine in certain areas, such provisions shall not be amended or~~
1.11 ~~removed unless 55 percent of the votes cast on the proposition shall be in favor thereof.~~
1.12 Notwithstanding any other law, a city charter may not restrict the ability of a city to issue
1.13 an intoxicating liquor license otherwise in compliance with applicable law.

1.14 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment.
