1.8	Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$12,725,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds
1.9	fund to the commissioner of public safety for a grant to the city of Brooklyn Park to acquire

1.11	station with space for a multiagency emergency operations center, regional training
