1.8 Subd. 2. **Driver and Vehicle Systems Oversight Committee established.** (a) The

1.9 Driver and Vehicle Systems Oversight Committee is established and consists of the following

1.10 members:

1.11 (1) the chair of the senate Finance Committee, or a senator appointed by the chair of the

1.12 senate Finance Committee;

1.13 (2) the chair and ranking minority member of the senate committee with jurisdiction

1.14 over transportation finance;

1.15 (3) the chair of the house of representatives Ways and Means Committee, or a member

1.16 of the house of representatives appointed by the chair of the house of representatives Ways

1.17 and Means Committee; and

1.18 (4) the chair and ranking minority member of the house of representatives committee

1.19 with jurisdiction over transportation finance.

1.20 (b) The chair of the Blue Ribbon Council on Information Technology, or the chair's

1.21 designee, must serve on the committee as a nonvoting member. If the council expires or is

1.22 dissolved, ~~this position on the committee is discontinued.~~ the chair of the council at the time

- 2.1 of expiration or dissolution, or the chair's designee, must continue to serve on the committee
- 2.2 as a nonvoting member until the committee expires as provided by subdivision 8.
