1.9	Development, LLC, for: (1) building and site improvements, including renovation of building
1.10	interior space, and for purchase of equipment and materials for training purposes at the
1.11	current site of the Regional Apprenticeship Training Center in Minneapolis; and (2) planning
1.12	activities necessary to evaluate the development of a new facility on a site in Minneapolis
1.13	currently owned by Northgate Development, LLC, or its wholly-owned subsidiary, to provide
1.14	renewable energy skills training.
1.15	(b) For the purposes of this section, "renewable energy skills training" means the design,
