1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 28A.10, is amended to read:

1.8All such licenses shall be issued for a period of one year and shall be posted or displayed

1.9in a conspicuous place at the place of business so licensed. ~~Except as provided in sections~~

34.07 BEVERAGE INSPECTION ACCOUNT; APPROPRIATION.

A beverage inspection account is created in the agricultural fund. All fees and fines collected under this chapter shall be credited to the beverage inspection account. Money in the account is appropriated to the commissioner for inspection and supervision under this chapter.
