1.5	Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2018, section 147D.03, subdivision 2, is amended to read:
1.6	Subd. 2. Scope of practice. The practice of traditional midwifery includes, but is not

1.8	(1) initial and ongoing assessment for suitability of traditional midwifery care;
1.9	(2) providing prenatal education and coordinating with a licensed health care provider
1.10	as necessary to provide comprehensive prenatal care, including the routine monitoring of
