1.7(a) \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2019 are appropriated

1.8from the general fund to the Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board for the

1.9Cooper/Sams volunteer ambulance program under Minnesota Statutes, section 144E.40. Of

1.10these amounts:

1.11(1) \$911,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$911,000 in fiscal year 2019 are for the ambulance

1.12service personnel longevity award and incentive program under Minnesota Statutes, section

1.13144E.40; and

1.14(2) \$89,000 in fiscal year 2018 and \$89,000 in fiscal year 2019 are for the operation of

1.15the ambulance service personnel longevity award and incentive program under Minnesota

1.16Statutes, section 144E.40.

1.17(b) \$3,000,000 in fiscal year 2018 is appropriated from the general fund to the
