on-site parking facilities. ~~Residential structures with fewer than four dwelling units are~~

~~exempt from this subdivision.~~ Single-family homes, two-family homes, and townhouses

that provide on-site parking shall be required by the code to provide not less than one

electric-vehicle-capable space per dwelling unit or parking space, whichever is less.
