1.1A bill for an act

1.2relating to environment; requiring exclusion of commercialized carbon dioxide

1.3from GREET model analysis of ethanol fuels; amending Minnesota Statutes 2020,

1.4section 116.07, by adding a subdivision.

1.5BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

1.6Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2020, section 116.07, is amended by adding a subdivision

1.7to read:

1.8Subd. 4m. Excluding captured carbon dioxide from GREET model analysis. (a) If

1.9the state adopts the GREET model to evaluate ethanol-containing fuels, any carbon dioxide

1.10that was captured by an ethanol plant, as defined in section 41A.09, and sold for commercial

1.11purposes must be excluded from consideration in the model.

1.12(b) For purposes of this subdivision, "GREET model" means the Greenhouse Gases,

1.13Regulated Emissions, and Energy Use in Transportation model or any other life cycle model

1.14that fully evaluates the energy and emission impacts of transportation fuels.

1.15EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
